JOB OVERVIEW

This role is to manage the strategy and long-term development of ORT UK's Trusts and Grants fundraising programme to:

- Grow the number, value and type of successful grant applications
- Manage the development of productive relationships with new funders
- Facilitate delivery of excellent grants management including improved regular reporting of outcomes and appropriate stewardship

Key Accountabilities/Responsibilities

- Develop and maintain knowledge and understanding of World ORT & ORT UK's programmes to ensure high-quality applications
- Responsible for researching and identifying potential prospects suitable for applications for World ORT & ORT UK projects as appropriate or per funding opportunities available for application
- Manage and develop ORT UK's existing portfolio of trusts and foundations to maximise sustainable restricted income
- Responsible to ensure applications are drafted and submitted within appropriate timeline meeting deadlines, working in collaboration with; the World ORT Program Operations Manager, ORT UK CEO and World ORT & ORT UK Programme teams to support the ongoing application process
- Work closely with World ORT & ORT UK to ensure clarity of relationship management and stewardship is in place and all gifts are captured accurately on the supporter database
- Actively participate in World ORT & ORT UK meetings and events as required
- Presenting to all parties on behalf of the organisation as required



Ideal Candidate Profile

The ideal candidate should be self-motivated, proactive, effective at decision making, should be able to demonstrate a high level of integrity and discretion in handling confidential information as well as professionalism in dealing with trustees, donors, and internal & external stakeholders.

Essential Skills

- Successful, recent track record of applications to trust and grant providers at six-figure level and above
- Experience of relationship management and stewardship of professional philanthropic organisations and individuals
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills able to complete complex applications and write compelling copy
- Numerate and able to use skills to formulate budgets, extract data and create reports
- Able to lead face to face meetings with existing and potential funding providers
- Proficient user of Windows-based software packages including Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, Microsoft Teams. Able to utilise cloud-based file sharing (Sharepoint, One Drive etc)
- Strong team player able to contribute to the wider ORT UK Fundraising and Marketing strategy as well as work effectively within a cross functional team with World ORT
