MENTORING PROGRAMME: a bespoke approach which matches students with professionals to build new networks and enabling them to gain new perspectives on the working world.

SKILLS DAYS: provide hands-on workshops with sector specialists who present real-life challenges for students to solve, offering practical insights into different industries.

TEAM CHALLENGE: focuses on developing leadership skills, teamwork, and creativity as a way for students to enhance their presentation and communication skills.

ALTERNATIVE WORK EXPERIENCE: is a modern take on work experience which spans a variety of industries and exposes students to diverse professional tasks and environments.

ORT JUMP helps students harness their natural talents and aspirations. The programmes create an experiential learning environment where students can explore their talents and interests and gain a broad understanding of the modern workplace and its dynamics.

Our tailored approach supports young people throughout their secondary education, making ORT JUMP an invaluable addition to the traditional curriculum and enhancing schools' ability to deliver the Gatsby Benchmarks. Our programmes facilitate valuable interactions between students and employers, providing insights into the aspirations and motivations of the next generation.

Case for Support

Unfortunately, far too many young people leave education every year without having had any work experience, often lacking essential workplace skills like etiquette, reliability, and flexibility. Young people need support to help to build the confidence, resilience, and sense of direction they need to meet the evolving demands of the workplace. At the same time, government investment in careers advice servicers in schools has been dramatically reduced.

ORT UK supports schools to tackle these critical issues. We offer students a unique, experiential learning environment which prepares them for the changing world of work and helps them develop their natural talents and match these with different pathways and opportunities.

Our programmes extend beyond the core curriculum, aiming to provide students with mentorship and skills training at no additional cost to schools. Following an independent evaluation from Coventry University in 2019, we are confident that our input enhances student outcomes and helps to foster cohorts of adaptable, resilient young people.

Currently, ORT UK works with 1,300 young people in London. Our goal over the next three years is to expand our reach to 2,500 students in two London boroughs and in Manchester, Leeds, Glasgow, and Brighton.

We harness a network of over 400 volunteers as facilitators and mentors who donate their time to our programmes and bring with them their experience of a wide range of industries, careers, and sectors. It is a sign of our success that over 10% of current mentors are alumni of the Mentoring Programme. Their input is essential.

We consider the needs of socially and economically disadvantaged students and those with SEN and other learning disabilities, to ensure that our programmes are inclusive and effective for all.
